

Regular School Board Meeting
I.S.D. 547, Parkers Prairie Public Schools

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of Independent School District 547, Parkers Prairie Public Schools, was called to order by Chairman Lyle Oeltjenbruns at 7:00PM. Motion by Hart, seconded by Eutenener and carried, to approve the amended agenda.

Motion by Euteneuer, seconded by Wagner and carried, to approve the minutes from the March regular board meeting.

Motion by Hart, seconded by Euteneuer and carried, to approve Hand Payable checks totaling \$76,304.5; Wire transfers totaling \$295,241.8; Board Payable I checks totaling \$111,274.39.

Superintendent Report:

- **Principal Reports:**
 - Principal Radtke
 - MCA testing is starting soon.
 - Cards were sent to eligible Kindergarten students/families. 31 families have indicated their child will attend Kindergarten in Parkers Prairie.
 - Kindergarten roundup was recently held. Families met with Kindergarten teachers, Principal Radtke and took a short bus ride.
 - Principal Johnson
 - MCA testing is complete. The ACT was recently administered.
 - Congratulations to the Speech team on their 11th Subsection championship and to the Knowledge Bowl team on qualifying for the State competition.
 - Additional information was provided on the Leader In Me program. The cost of the program is based on the number of students involved. Students currently in 7th and 8th grade had this program at the Elementary.

Motion by Hart, seconded by Wagner and carried, to begin the program in the 2022-23 school year for the 7th and 8th grade students, in 2023-24 (second year) for grades 7 - 9, in 2024-25 (third year) for grades 7 – 10 and in 2025-26 (4th year) for grades 7 – 11.

- Technology Committee report –
 - The Technology Committee met on March 29
 - Possible purchases for the 2022-23 school year include access points, servers, laptops, chromebooks, and flat screen panels with a total cost of \$100,795.
 - Discussion on rebuilding the website. A proposal was received for this service with a one-time fee of \$2,300 for setup and training and \$495/year ongoing support.

Motion by Schilling, seconded by Inwards and carried, to approve the purchase of the items recommended by the Technology Committee and accept the proposal by DataBae Systems for website redesign.

 - **The House and Senate have released their budgets. The House proposes \$1.155 billion on education. The Senate's bill included \$30 million.**
